The Amazon will impress by its vastness of water and forest. Much of its diversity of animals, birds, flowers, fruits, and insects are high up in the trees or hidden in the undergrowth, active at night or below the water. With a good guide and a bit of patience the visitor will slowly discover the enchantments of the forest. For the best encounters with nature and the Amazon biome, we recommend staying in one of the jungle lodges offered on out proposal.

ITINERARY

Day 01 - Transfer from Manaus Airport to hotel in Manaus Upon arrival in Manaus, meet & greet by an English speaking local guide and transfer to your hotel in Manaus.

Day 2 – Manaus / Amazon Rain Forest - The Evolution Lodge. Breakfast and transfer from hotel to Evolution lodge. Up on arrival, lodge activities and full board.

Day 3 - Full day activities and meals are included. Bellow activities are Based on the Evolution Lodge. Breakfast. Jungle Trekking. Lunch. Canoeing with fishing of piranhas and take some time to contemplate the sunset. Dinner. Caiman Spotting.


Day 4 – Amazon Rain Forest - The Evolution Lodge

The Amazon: Where Life Flows with the Water

The mythical Amazon Rainforest covers an area of more than 5 million square kilometers of which 80% is in Brazilian territory. It is the largest intact rainforest in the world. More than a thousand rivers flow through the Amazon, accounting for a fifth of the world's fresh surface water. Rich with life, the Amazon holds 30% of world's biodiversity with many species yet to be identified by science.
